Pear WILLIAM B.C.

Tree: variety with upright habit and medium-high vigour. Poor grafting compatibility with quince, so an intergraft is recommended.

Bears fruit early, good productivity.

Fruit: medium size, pyriform shape. Yellow skin with rusty areas of varying size near the stem. May be more reddish in colour in the areas most exposed to the sun.

Very fine, white, soft, sweet pulp, with an excellent flavour.

Picking season: benchmark variety. Picked between 5 and 15 August, depending on the climatic conditions of the season and the altitude.
